### **September 2, 2014**

Meeting opened at 6:30 p.m. Chris, Penny and Clem were present.

Selectmen approved minutes from the previous meeting.

Treasurer's report reviewed and approved.

New Business:

Debbie Doyon was at the meeting to see if there is anything that can be done about her neighbor's barking dogs. The owners of the dogs, Ted & Lisa Reynolds were also at the meeting along with ACO Sue Dwyer. Ted said that Debbie had never contacted him regarding the dogs. She did contact the ACO periodically to report the barking. Unity does have a "Barking Dog Ordinance" that was enacted in 1983. MMA legal is currently reviewing the ordinance and other barking dog court cases to see if it would be upheld in court. No action was made at this time.

Clem agreed to be Unity's rep at the Household Hazardous Waste Day to be held October 4<sup>th</sup>.

Summer road work update: The roadside mowing is almost completed. Town Farm reclaiming should start next week. Possibly some ditch work can be started on Waning Road this fall.

Clem expressed concern about the Comprehensive Plan survey that is out now. He feels that the survey was steering and manipulative and the questions were geared to be long and redundant to break the recipient down on issues and support non-profits specifically by name. We do not need name recognition in the survey. It is not about the non-profits; it is about the Town of Unity and its citizens.
